Philip Hal Rasor went to meet his Creator and join his parents and deceased friends on April 17, 2017 at his home in Kerrville, Texas.

On September 9, 1943 his parents, Hal and Isabel Rasor, were presented with a beautiful baby boy in Hawthorne, Ca. At the age of two he moved to Anson, Texas where he resided until graduation from Anson High. In between jobs he had several businesses and managed to work on his Masters at the University of Texas and the University of Houston. Upon retiring he returned to Anson where he built customized computers and also did repair. In his spare time he spent many hours on the golf course while also assisting Clyda with her nursery business.

He was preceded in death by his parents Hal and Isabel Rasor and two brother in laws, Jimmy and Gary Faulks.

He is survived by his wife, Clyda of 57 years; five children, 10 grandchildren, 17 great grandchildren and 2 great great grandchildren.
